The Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture

Visit for Students

The Research Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture organized a visit for the students of 2020-2023 batch to the prestigious Govt. Fish Seed Hatchery, Peechi, Thrissur, for a day and night programme. Scientific measures have been adopted by this facility to improve the survival rate of the seed and the results were evidentthrough the income generated from the sales of fish seed during the financial year 2021-2022.

Students were able to take part in activities like identification of male and female brooders through physical examination, calculation of hormonal dose and its administration to conditioned brood stock, different sites for hormone administration, milt extraction- stripping; testis extraction and maceration with normal saline, egg collection methods for adhesive and floating eggs, dip treatment methods for the eradication of microbial agents, natural and artificial egg collection substrates, field identification of aquatic plants, insects fishes like Torkhudree, Wallago attu, Clarius batrachus, Anabas testudineus, Labeo rohu, Catla catla, Ctenopharyngodon idella, Cyprinus carpio, GIFT and fry of catla, rohu, Anabas etc. Students actively participated in routine farming activities which involved, removal of leaves and other fallen particles/debris from the pond, feed broadcasting to all the 50 nursery and rearing ponds of the farm, water quality monitoring and record maintenance; setting up of a (low cost/ backyard) dismantlable type eco hatchery.


Poster Making Competition






The Department of Botany

As part of World Environment Day, the students of II BCom Taxation conducted a programme






The Department of Commerce (SF)








The Department of English (SF)




Industrial Talk
