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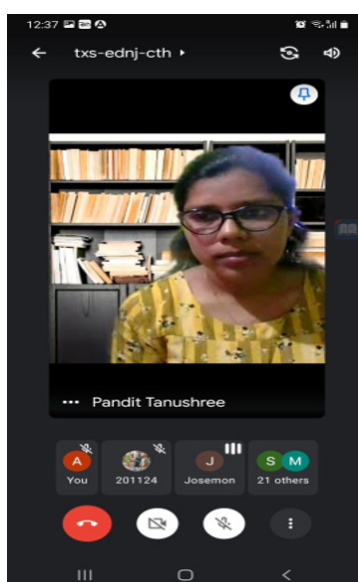

Hands on Training Programme on “Technical Scripting Using LaTeX”

From 10 to 12 and 16 to 17 August 2022, 8.00 am to 10.00 am The Department of Mathematics and Statistics, organized a Hands-on Training Programme on “Technical Scripting Using LaTeX in Overleaf” from 10 to 12 August and from 16 to 17 August. About 41 students – 22 from III BSc Mathematics and 19 from II MSc Mathematics – participated in the programme. The objective of the programme was to make the students proficient enough in the high-quality typesetting system namely LaTeX which includes features designed for the production of technical and scientific documentation and to equip the students to prepare their dissertation using LaTeX. The training was designed as a 10-hour programme, with 4 hours for theory and 6 hours for practicals respectively. Dr. Divya Mary Daise S and Dr. Binu M, the faculty coordinators of the programme handled the theory and practical sessions respectively. Assignments which requires the use LaTeX were allotted to the students and were provided graded certificates according to the submission.


Invited Lecture: "Basics of Research Methodology for Literature Students"


Industrial Visit 2 – Core Renew Expo, Kochi
