




#### **Photography Competition**


### SPARSCH (Social Outreach Programme of Albertian Royal Society of Chemists)




# **Department of Botany**


# Department of Commerce SF (AN)








#### **Faculty Achievement**




# **Department of Journalism And Mass Communication**

Santhosh, the student coordinator.












# **Department of Renewable Energy**


# A talk on My Story: The journey and transformation to an entrepreneur




#### Webinar on Renewable Energy for a Sustainable World
