TWO DAY WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

On 19th and 20th July 2019, Department of Commerce and Research Centre of St. Albert's College (Autonomous) hosted a two day workshop on Research Methodology.



On first day, the session commenced at 8.30 AM with a prayer song. Dr. Tia Mathews (H.O.D of commerce) welcomed the gathering. Dr Mukesh P was the resource person for the programme. After that, the session started. It was an interactive and beneficial session by Dr. Mukesh P. He started by giving a brief idea on research and various procedures to be included for conducting a research in a simple manner with practical knowledge. Then an insight was given into SPSS. A detailed session on how to use SPSS, how to enter data in it and different tools used to analyze and interpret data using SPSS was also delivered by the resource person. On day 1, descriptive analysis tools were described. A brief description on reliability testing and models were also given by the resource person.

On second day, Dr Mukesh P, gave an idea on hypothesis, its types and different tests used. Different tests explained includes one-sample t test, independent t- test, one-way ANOVA and the corresponding non-parametric tests. The session was very useful and interesting one which gave practical knowledge on research to inspire the students as well as teachers to come up with their best in academic activities. There was an opportunity for student representatives of P.G to share the feedback of session after the concluding words by Dr. Tia Mathews.

TRAINING PROGRAMME ON PUBLIC SPEAKING

Department of Commerce organised Training Programme on Public Speaking for the students of 3rd B.Com Taxation of St Albert's college Ernakulam. The program was conducted in two sessions. The speaker of the day was Robin Mathew, Motivational Trainer.

On the first day, 19th July 2019, he gave a detailed explanation about how a public speaking should be and about the basics of public speaking. He talked about the key aspects like structure of a speech, facial expression, movements, dress code, microphone, sound modulation, eye contact, the vision and mission of our speech, time management, visual aids etc.. that should be followed. The next session was conducted on 19th November 2019. The overall session was good and it really helped a lot of students who had a fear of facing the public and hope that it will help the students in their future whenever they have to address a gathering.

It was officially handed over and released to Prinicpal, Dr. M.L Joseph by Vice Principal, Dr.Rosalind Gonzaga during the inauguration of department social outreach program 'SORRY'.

"THOOLIKA"-An initiative of paper pen making.

Every living being have an environment where they exists. The factors or forces in the environment have an influence on them. It plays an important role in the healthy living of human beings. It matters because it is the only home that humans have. It provides air, food, and other needs. Humanity's entire life support system depends on the well-being of all the environmental factors. The negative forces in the environment will adversely affect the human life and we are the people who paved the way for this negative impact. So obviously it is our responsibility as a human being to track the solution for this deadly situation. The lion share of this problem is carried by plastic, which is a material made to last forever. These are used for just once and thrown away. Plastic cannot biodegrade; it breaks down into smaller and smaller pieces only. Toxic chemicals leach out of plastic and are found in the blood and tissue of nearly all of us. Exposure to them is linked to cancers, birth defects, impaired immunity, endocrine disruption and other ailments.

It is our very time to take necessary steps to cut down the uses of this threatening material,' plastic'. As an initial footstep, the department of commerce and research Centre of St. Albert's college, Ernakulam had developed a programme named "SORRY"- Shouldn't Our Resources Remain Yearlong. The project Bhoomika was launched under this programme.

As a part of Bhoomika initiative named "Thoolika" the students of the II M.Com made paper pens in order to reduce the plastic left over which are produced by using other types of pens. In the first phase, they taught II B.Com students and through them they targeted to campaign the need to use these pens among the school students as they are the upcoming generation who can make changes in the society. In order to induce the students use these pens the initiators also announced the contest. That is, the students were asked to plant those seeds while disposing the pen after use. And they were asked to take a selfie with the plant and send it to the email that has been provided.





In the second phase they expanded the programme by reaching to schools in and around the city and taught them to make those pens and spread the awareness to use eco-friendly products. The major motive behind these projects was to develop entrepreneurship skills among the students and induce them to bring changes.

"CARRY" - An initiative of paper bag making.

Green Protocol is the need of the hour and the same leads to a sustainable and enriched environment which has been one of the most pertinent discussion worldwide in the past few decades. As the cases of global pollution and increased use of plastic are creating a trauma for our mother earth it is the responsibility of each one of us to minimize and mitigate this problem. One of the most effective step to handle this situation is to reduce the use of plastics in our day to day uses. As a substitute for plastic products like plastic bags we would like to use paper bags which is a big ecofriendly step.

The Commerce Department of St. Albert's College has launched a programme "CARRY-Conservate. Abate. Recycle. Reuse . Yourself" under the project "BHOOMIKA" to promote the use of paper bags and teach the students to make their own paper bags. It was being carried out so as to make the child self-dependent on creating their own bags and to not to depend outside.





The one day paper bag workshop was handled by Prof. Sharan Hilary of Department of Commerce. Students were asked to bring their own chart papers and Prof. Sharan Hilary clearly described the paper bag making process. The method adopted and taught by him was very simple and precise and students found it very simple to adopt towards his methods. The second time students were able to make their own bags and some of the bags were even decorated and made attractive. Each student was aware of his duty towards nature and each one was enthusiastic in promoting this scheme and spreading awareness regarding this project.

The second step of this scheme was to spread awareness to the public and teach them to make paperbags. The students of St. Albert's H.S.S., Ernakulam were taught to make paper bags by the students of St. Alberts College. They were also asked to promote this programme and was taught the ill effects of using plastic bags.

The main idea of this project is to raise this scheme to an entrepreneurship level. This would have a net positive effect on the natural environment and at the same time is financially sustainable. Paper bags are gaining importance as these bags are 100% reusable, recyclable and biodegradable and at the same time environment friendly and pose less threat to wildlife. A paper bag's structural firmness and surface feature made it ideal to print high-quality images, logo, designs better as compared to a plastic bag, and that made paper bags a hit for fashion, luxury and premium gift packaging industry. Project "CARRY" would promote sustainable entrepreneurship which can turn into the driving force for the emergence of a new holistic sustainable system in the three dimensions — economy, environment, and society.

GROUP DISCUSSION ON 'SORRY SHOULDN'T OUR RESOURCES REMAIN YEARS LONG'.

On December 12, 2019 the team of SORRY met for the second time for discussing and planning the event 'SORRY' that we had done successfully with St. Albert's School earlier. The discussion focused on developing our project to reach a wide coverage especially on Ernakulam City. The GD was initiated by Dr. Tia Mathews and she had welcomed Fr. Jolly John Odathakal, Asst. Manager of St. Albert's College to this GD. Vice Principle Dr. Rosalind Gonzaga had assisted. Some others had suggested that we should extent this to high school and college level. At last Father had suggested that it would be better to select 4 to 7th standard students so that it is easy to get them as other groups will be busy about their academic studies and also former groups will catch ideas better. Difna also suggested that planting a tree should be given as assignments. Oliviya and Gretta had talk about collecting waste dress materials and making useful items like mats, bags etc. Sachu and Akash added idea of entrepreneurship of making cloth bags.

Tia madam had suggested Thushara for doing the same as a coordinator. Thushara had suggested that students should be given some incentives for collecting plastic and she explained the same model in Pune. Ann Martin suggested that it would be better to conduct follow up activities rather than one time visit. Prof. Tia Mathews added that we should form clubs and a faculty should be connected.



After everyone had shared their experience, opinions, ideas and suggestions about the project 'SORRY' Fr. Jolly John Odathakal volunteered and summarized the main points that we would remember and adopted.


INTRA-DEPARTMENT SPORTS DAY


