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THE DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH: FROM THE SEEDS



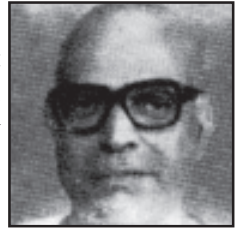
‘Historians’ of St. Albert’s College, such as Professor Premus Perinchery, tells us that the college started in the twin Gothic style buildings of St. Albert’s School on 16 July 1946, a year before Indian independence (Perinchery 157). It is not clear if an English Department existed in those hazy days. However, the college was shifted to the present campus in 1951, even though the work of the new building was incomplete as yet.

Let me present before you the faculty who have worked in the English Department right from its inception to the present. The Late Prof. K.J.S. Cleetus, father of our former Principal Prof. Harry Cleetus and one of the students of the first batch of St. Albert’s College, mentions Rev. Fr. Bonaventure and Prof. Velayudhan Nair, popularly known as ‘Shakespeare Velayudhan,’ as the English faculty of St. Albert’s College in its infancy (Cleetus 161).

FORMER FACULTY

Prof. A.P. Matthai(1948-1974)

Classmate of Malayalam poet Changampuzha, he was the first Head of the Department of English, serving in that capacity from 1948 to 1974. His knowledge of the canonical works in English literature, generally, and Shakespearean plays specifically, had made his lectures memorable for the students of that era. His education under noted Oxonian scholars Fr. Murphy and Fr. Gilmore had equipped him with a solid basis in English literature. He was an eloquent speaker, deft at giving off-hand speeches at short notice. The condolence speech he delivered impromptu on the occasion of the death of the Pope of that period – about whom no one in the college knew enough – was particularly memorable, teachers of those days recount. He was also known to be a consultant of the Kerala High Court in plagiarism cases. Besides being an authority in his subject, he was also known to be a Latin scholar. Prof. Matthai showed zero tolerance towards errors in English, spoken or written by his students and colleagues. If someone inadvertently spelt his name with a single ‘t,’ Prof. Matthai was quick to point it out.



The concept of Spoken English was popularized in Kochi by Prof. Matthai, when he started his own institute for Spoken English – ‘Mase’ – after his retirement. His death on 27 February 1993 pained all the lovers of St. Albert’s College.

Prof. P.M. Thomas Pulikan (1950-80)

He was an adept in teaching grammar and well-versed in Latin as well. After his retirement, he devoted his time and energy to Vincent De Paul Society. He was the first member of St. Albert’s College Co-operative Society.



Prof. E.V. Stanislavos(1951-82)

He was well-known for his exam-oriented approach.



Prof. E.V. Paul (1949-1983)

He was the Head of the Department from 1974 till his retirement in 1983. A fluent teacher of English, his classes were so laced with humour that the students experienced no boredom even after hours of attending his sessions. He was good at teaching fiction.



Prof. M.V. Augustine (1952-1983)

A sincere teacher, he became a Gandhian early in his student life, after meeting the Mahatma directly in Tiruchirappally. A social worker who turned even his home 'SevaBhavan' in Vypin for the service of others, he met the great Sarvodaya leader Vinobhaji in Kalady. Eminent leaders like Kelappaji have visited 'SevaBhavan.' After retirement, he was the secretary of Gandhi Peace Foundation, and later the Director of Gandhi Darshan. His colleagues describe him as "a friend in need."



Prof. Gerson S. Kannikal (1961-1984)

An efficient teacher, he was the Head of the Department from 1983 to 1984. He was the NCC officer of the college for long years. After retirement, he became a social worker, devoting his time and energy to St. Vincent De Paul Society.



Prof. N.J. Antony (1973-1985)

The soft-spoken Prof. N.J. Antony was known for his dedication and sincerity.

Prof. John Chakalakal (1961-1988)

A persevering, committed teacher, he was a man of ideas. The idea of a Staff Club for St. Albert's College and the St. Albert's College Alumni Association were mooted by him. In later years, these became important organizational wings of the college. As a teacher, his well-modulated voice and articulation was able to keep students in thrall till the session was over.



His publications include *Modern American Poetry*, *Socrates – a Study*, *The Story of a Child*, *The Memoirs of Gandhiji*, and *The Way of Life*. He visited and taught abroad for a number of years. After his retirement, he was associated with the Gandhi Peace Foundation and Gandhi Darshan.

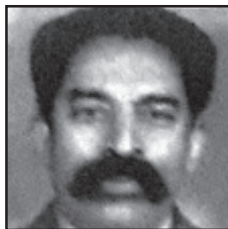
Prof. E.A. Thomas (1961-1992)

He was the Head of the Department from 1984 till his retirement in 1992. A die-hard grammarian and noteworthy teacher, Prof. Thomas had an addiction for reference books and used to be the proud owner of a formidable collection of them while he was in service.



Prof. A. J. Menon (1961-1990)

A strong disciplinarian with a good command of English and knowledge of literature, he helped the college authorities to maintain discipline in the campus.



Prof. A.C. John (1980-2004)

Excellent grammarian with a powerful voice, he rarely spoke Malayalam while on duty. A good singer, he impressed all with his active participation in the cultural programmes of the Staff Club.



Prof. Rajasekharan Kartha (1980-2005)

Known for his accuracy in both the spoken and written forms of the English language, he shone with his ability to adapt to any classroom situation, particularly large combined classes.



Prof. K.N. John Nicholas (1979-2007)

He was the Head of the Department from 1992 till his retirement. A multi-faceted personality, his approach to English and teaching was in a sense cosmopolitan. Perhaps he was the first teacher of the Department to encourage



students to think on a global scale – how their language skills ought to enable them to survive in a totally alien land and situation. Among other skills, he also practiced yoga, kalaripayattu and vocal classical music. A person with an extremely sensitive mind, he loved to live among books and used to have a formidable collection.

Prof. Rajoy Alex Paul Alfes (1980-2007)

An excellent teacher, it is difficult to come across a more affable person. A person with very strong writing skills, he had a nose for detecting good writing abilities among students. Gifted with a mellifluous voice, he would sing comfortably on social occasions.



Prof. K.P. Thomas (1982-2011)

He was Head of the Department from 2007 till his retirement in 2011. He is perhaps the most humorous HOD who has ever worked in the Department. A penchant even to make fun of himself to drive home a point made him popular among his students and colleagues. His personality was such that those who met him once was unlikely to forget him. Prof. K.P. Thomas started the BEC (Business English Course), which was able to attract much interest from students of the college as well as the public. The B.A. English as well as the M.A. English courses were sanctioned and begun while he was HOD.



Dr. Thomas Sebastian (1982-2013)

Head of the Department from 2011 till his retirement. An expert in modernist poetry, he impressed students with his depth of knowledge in his subject.



Prof. T.J. Joseph Xavier (1984-2011)

His perseverance and patience were near legendary. He believed that students would benefit much from writing assignments, tests and write-ups, thereby engaging them continually. He was known to correct student tasks well past



midnight. A social worker of the quiet kind, he visited hospitals comforting patients and helping them in their need.

Dr. Edward Edezhath(1983-2013)

Equipped with a suave, affable personality, he stood for Parliament from the Ernakulam Lok Sabha Constituency. He was perhaps the first person in the Department and the college to use the email, even when the use of the internet had not become widespread. He



is a person known to use the latest communication devices. An excellent teacher, he is never known to have any friction with the students, who loved him more than anyone else. One of the noteworthy achievements of Dr. Edward Edezhath was the UGC Major Research Programme he successfully conducted titled, *Remnants of Portuguese Colonization* completed in 2012. At present he has an ongoing post-doctoral UGC Major Research Programme under his belt titled *Documenting and Analysis of Children's Folk Games of Kerala*. Prof. Nisha Thomji Varghese is the co-investigator of this project. Dr. Edward Edezhath has travelled so extensively that we can say without hesitation that no other teacher at St. Albert's College has visited as many countries as he has.

Dr. Vijayan A.V. (1983-2014)

Head of the Department from 2013 to 2014, this soft-spoken voracious reader has the ability to quench any doubt likely to arise in the mind of even the most knowledge-thirsty student. He is a research guide of Bharatiyar University. He is a master of yoga, and his encyclopedic knowledge makes him an excellent quiz master.



Dr. Leslie Thomas (1984-2016)

Dr. Leslie Thomas (1984-2016) Ever since Dr. Leslie Thomas assumed charge as the Head of the Department in April 2014, there have been marked changes. The new faces of the freshly-appointed faculty invigorated the

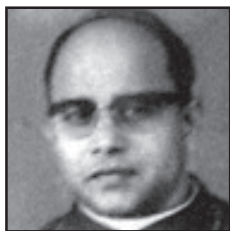


Department, with the HOD being the sole representative of the older generation. With his penchant for publishing, one of the thrust areas of the Department during his tenure has been publication and creativity. The Department was able to bring out three publications during his tenure, the scholarly *Albertian Review of Literature* (ARL), the light-hearted student publication *Magazine of English Literature and Arts* (MELA) and also the first edition of the *English Department Yearbook* (EDY).

FACULTY WHO HAVE WORKED FOR SHORT PERIODS

Most Rev. Dr. Joseph Kelanthara

It is extremely rare for a department of a college to have the good fortune of one of its faculty chosen as Archbishop. Our Department was blessed with such a benevolence when Dr. Joseph Kelanthara was appointed Archbishop of Verapoly, having served as English Professor in the Department from 1966 to 1968. He also served for a short period at the Mangalapuzha Seminary.



Prof. K.J. Augustine

One of the early English professors of St. Albert's College. A thinker and erudite person, his colleagues used to call him affectionately 'Modern Socrates.' He was also an excellent orator and a good writer, equally proficient in both English and Malayalam.



Rev. Fr. Joseph Thottakath

While serving as English Professor, he also donned the role of acting Principal for a few months.

Rev. Fr. George Chillikoodan

He was appointed Principal of St. Paul's College, Kalamassery, while he was working in the English Department.

Dr. K.M. Tharakan

Well-known literary critic Dr. K.M. Tharakan worked in the English Department from 1957 to 1959, when he left to take up a

teaching post at Mar Athanasious College, Kothamangalam. A prolific writer, he later shone as the president of the Sahitya Academy.

Dr. E.V. Francis

He has worked for a short while in the English Department. Later he took a doctorate from Harvard University and had the unique distinction of being appointed as faculty in Harvard University. His area of specialization was “Emerson and Hindu Scriptures,” which also happened to his research topic. He has written a novel called *Lost Horizon*.

Prof. K.J. Titus

He has worked in the English Department for a short while and left to join the FACT, where he retired as Personnel Manager.

Prof. C.T. Sukumaran

He was working in the English Department when he was selected to the I.A.S. He passed away in mysterious circumstances while in service in the I.A.S.

Prof. P. Eliseus

He worked for a short while in the English Department before he left to take up a teaching assignment abroad. A fluent speaker he was known for his histrionic abilities and his love for drama.



PRESENT FACULTY

Ms. Nisha Thomji Varghese

The present Head of the Department and the first permanent woman faculty of the English Department, Prof. Nisha Thomji Varghese who joined the Department in 2012 has been able to bring in abundant energy. She figures prominently in many of the important committees of the college, such as the Women’s Empowerment Cell, The Extended Executive and the Co-operative Society, to name only a few. She initiated the Drachma Yon, serving the poor and the needy from the one-rupee a day donations made by the students of the



Department. Under her leadership, the Department initiated Lebenah Aheb meaning Bricks of Love, a project designed to construct a house for one of the cleaning staff of the college. Drachma Yon and Lebenah Aheb are part of the extension activities of the Department. At present, she is Research Associate of a UGC Major Project with Dr. Edward Edezhath titled, Documenting and Analysis of Children's Folk Games of Kerala."

Mr. Sebastian A. V.

He joined the Department in 2013, after working for a period of ten years as Higher Secondary School Teacher at St. Albert's High School and other government aided schools. During his tenure here, he has shone with his innovative interactive teaching methods, such as the 'Macbethfest,' which he initiated successfully.



A person who values his words and expends few of them, he helps students, not only in the college but outside, with his expert counselling. He is a member of a number of committees in the college, including the IQAC.

Dr. Appu Jacob John

Since joining the Department in 2013, he has excelled as technical adviser of the Department publications. His perseverance in contacting and bringing eminent personalities to the Department has been very fruitful for the students. It has enabled them to gain more



exposure and familiarize them with the contemporary streams of thought. Dr. Appu Jacob John's PhD thesis on Tibetan poetry has been widely appreciated and seen as path-breaking. His research guide had initially tried to dissuade him from taking up this topic, on account of various issues likely to arise. But Appu was firm in his resolve. An excellent writer of Malayalam prose, Appu has also famously translated into Malayalam the controversial Tamil novel, Mathorupakan. He is the Assistant Tutor of Second B.A. English.

He has published four scholarly books - *Resistance in Exile: A Study of Tibetan Poetry in English*, *Behind the Lion's Roar: An Analysis of Tom and Jerry Cartoons*, *Metafiction as a Tool in Kurt Vonnegut Jr.'s Slaughter House Five* and *Ramblings in Neo-Literatures*.

Mr. George Vineeth N. J.

He joined the English Department as Assistant Professor in 2014. He has brought abundant dynamism to the Department. A product of the Central University of Hyderabad, he has taught for a year at Christ School, Bangalore. He has also secured a Master's Degree in Philosophy from TMV, Pune. He is the Staff Coordinator of *TEA @ albert's*, the students' association of the Department. He is also the Academic Coordinator of the *English Enrichment Programme (EEP)*, the supportive course of the English Department, which caters to the needs of the Undergraduate students of the various disciplines in the college. He is the Tutor and Mentor of Second B.A. English. He is also an active member of various important college bodies, such as the admission committee. He is on the editorial board of ARL, St. Albert's College. His jovial personality enables him to create a good rapport with the persons he comes across. He has introduced several innovative teaching methods, such as teaching British History through illustration tasks by students. He has gained wide exposure by residing in many metropolitan cities of India as well as travelling abroad.



Mr. John Sinoj

He joined the English Department as Assistant Professor in 2014. But his association with the college stretches back to the student days, having graduated in English Literature from the same Department and post-graduation from Maharaja's College. A person who meticulously strives to expand his horizon of knowledge, he has embarked on a fresh adventure in M.A. Linguistics from Annamalai University,



having already acquired PGDHE (Post Graduate Diploma in Higher Education) of IGNOU. His unbounded energy and diligence have come in handy for the English Department. He is presently the Circulation Manager of all English Department Publications.

Dr. Mary Sapna Peter Miranda

Sapna Miranda joined the Department in 2014. She has previously worked with Christ College, Rajkot and Nirma University, Ahmedabad. She has completed and submitted her Ph.D under the full time Research and



Teaching Assistant (RTA) scheme of IGNOU, New Delhi. Her Ph.D thesis on Second Language Acquisition is the first of its kind, which seeks to understand the learner profile from both the traditional face-to-face set up and the open and distance mode of teaching-learning. She has many publications to her credit and has presented papers in seminars and conferences across India. Her areas of research interest include second language acquisition, sociolinguistics, criticism, gender studies and poetry. She is also a regular reviewer and contributor to various journals and magazines. Sapna is the editorial supervisor of MELA, the department in-house magazine for students. She is on the editorial board of ARL, St. Albert's College and IJLL, New Delhi.

Harrisian Forum for Critical Discourses in Humanities



V. C. Harris (1958 -2017) was an Indian film director, film and literary critic, and university professor. Harris was born in Mahé in 1958. After completing his secondary education at Jawaharlal Nehru Government Higher Secondary School, he began his undergraduate course at S. N. College, Kannur, followed by postgraduate studies at the English Department of the University of Calicut. Afterwards he worked as lecturer of English at Farook College, Calicut, and later at the School of Letters of the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kerala. On 5 October 2017, Harris was involved in an accident, and was admitted to the Government Medical College, where he died four days later on 9 October.

The Department had started a new initiative in memory of late Prof. V. C. Harris, Professor of English, School of Letters, Mahatma Gandhi University. Harris was one of the rare bio intellectuals who had always challenged his students. He was some one who is known for his constant influences with the many issues of the Kerala community. He was also a guiding light for many colleges and other institutions in and around Kerala. His circle did not limit him to the narrow borders of Kerala but to the ends of the world. He was instrumental in fostering the spirit of research in many of the colleges.

To preserve his glorious memory and to equip the coming generations to be socially conscious the department has opened a new forum titled Harrisian Forum for Critical Discourses in Humanities. This is a forum designed to discuss the various ideas of students and through a discursive mode inculcate in them a wider world view and better perception of humanity; thus reinstating the value of a discursive humanities.

The forum has two mentors in guiding the activities. Prof. Josy Joseph, Assoc. Professor in English, S B College (Autonomous), Changanacherry and Prof. Cheri Jacob K., Asst. Professor and Head of the Dept. of English, U C College, Aluva are the mentors who are guiding the students in their discourses. They interact with the students and supplement several topics of their study and equip them.
