


#### WEBINAR SERIES ON PROJECT REPORT PREPARATION- PART 1





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
#### **IMPRESARIO 2020, ENTREPRENEURIAL TALK SERIES #1**

#### **CAREER TALK**




# NATIONAL WEBINAR ON FINANCIAL REPORTING AND ACCOUNTING STANDARDS


#### **PATRIOTIC SONG COMPETITION**



## WEBINAR ON WOMEN EMPOWERMENT: AN EFFECTIVE TOOL FOR DEVELOPMENT



### **DISTRIBUTION OF EASTER KITS**



#### WEBINAR ON "INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS"






### WEBINAR ON WINDING UP OF THE COMPANIES




### WEBINAR ON THE DYNAMICS OF CAREER IN CMA
