



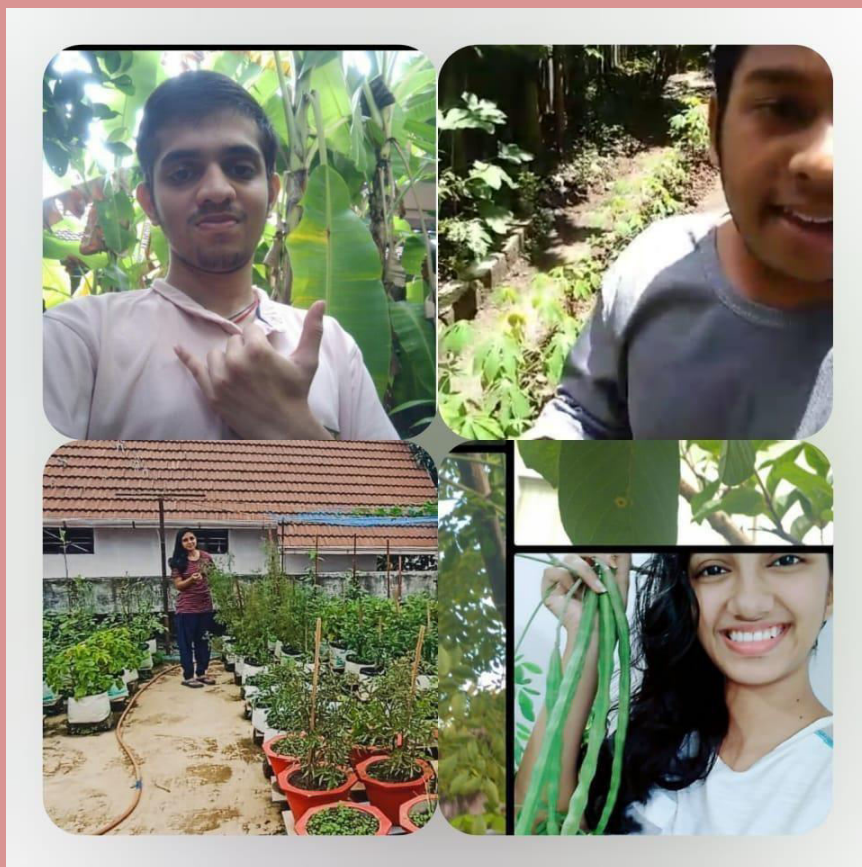
ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATION

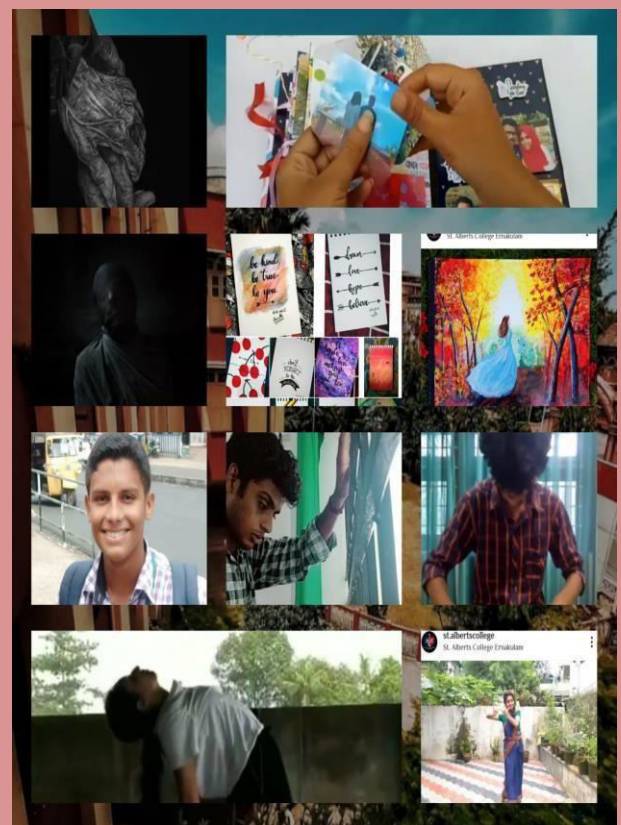
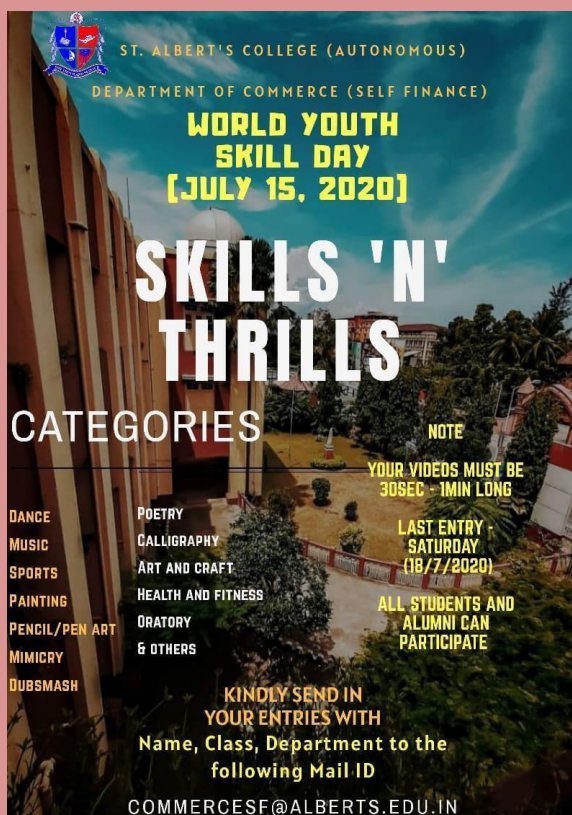

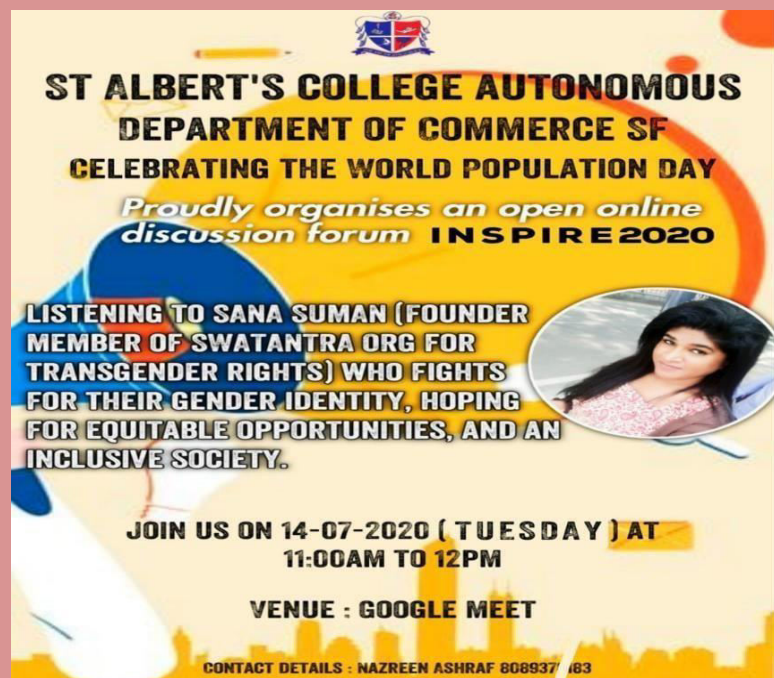

OPEN ONLINE DISCUSSION FORUM -INSPIRE 2020



WEBINAR WITH TECH GIANT-JOY SEBASTIAN



DISTRIBUTION OF EASTER KITS



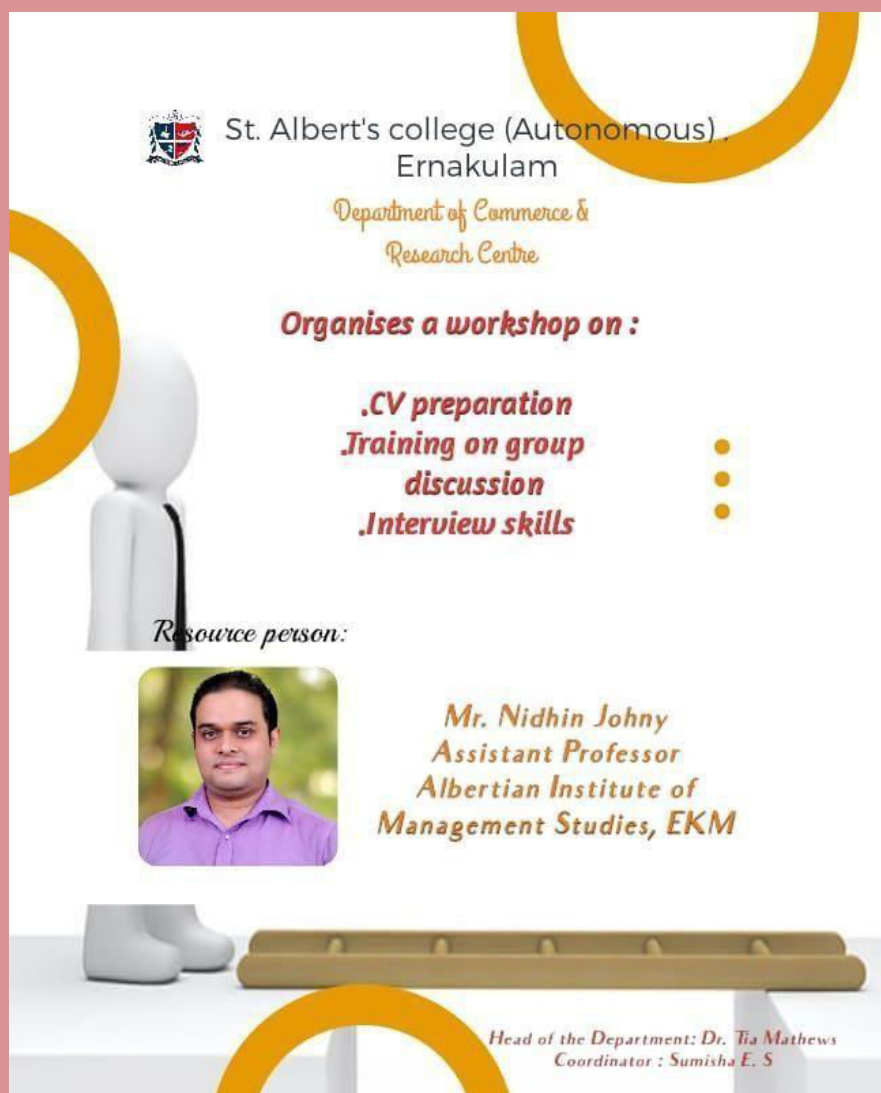

WEBINAR ON WINDING UP OF THE COMPANIES

As an initiative to provide expert lecture to the students, the department of Commerce (SF) of St. Albert's College (Autonomous)Ernakulam, conducted a webinar on the topic - 'Winding up of the Companies'. The webinar was conducted for the students of B.com Taxation (SF) and B.com Computer Applications. CS Nikhil George Pinto was both the chief guest and the resource person of the webinar. The most important part of the session was the separate Q&A, where the students were given opportunity to clear their doubts. He added that the flexible college timing helped him to carry out his professional studies along with his graduation. 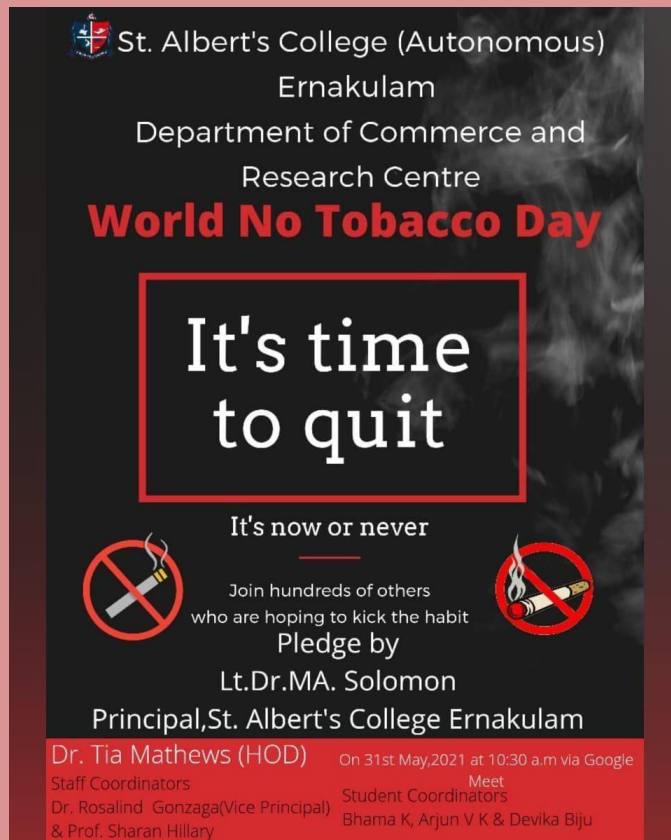

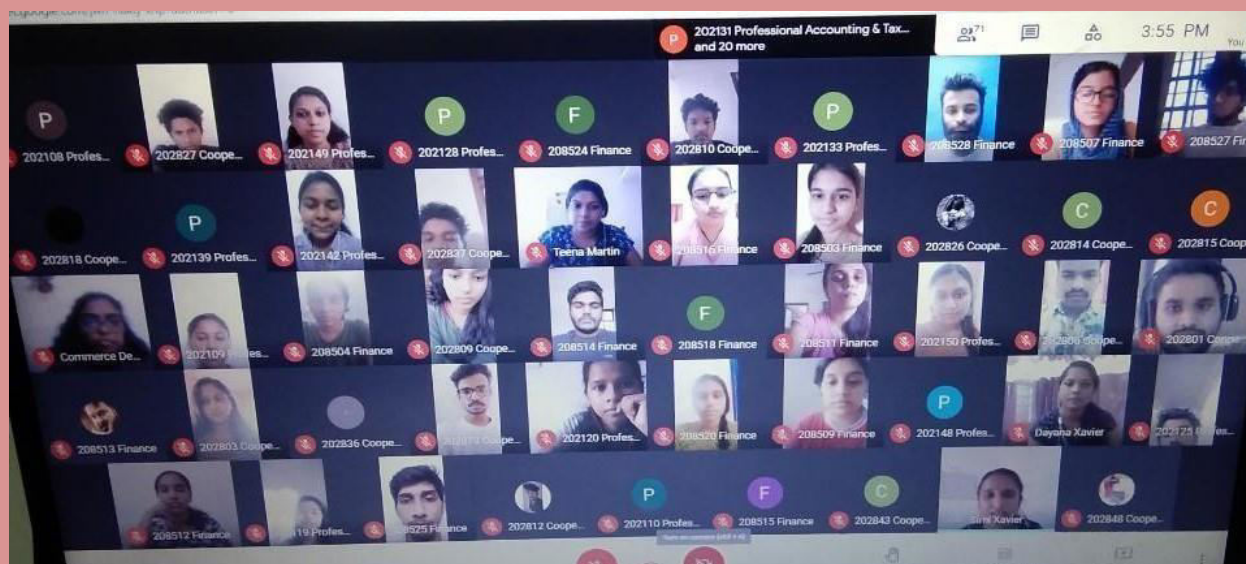
WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY CELEBRATION
