

## VILLAGE ADOPTION

Adoption of 06 Villages were done under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan programme of the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Extension activities including socio-economic status surveys, medical camps and workshops with the support of City Hospital and Lourdes Hospital, activities to up-bring differently-abled children in the community, distribution of essentials, study materials and assistive facilities to the schools, fests and flash mobs by differently-abled children and drug awareness workshops with the regional Excise Office were conducted.
