Method of computing per day usage of library:

For calculating the per day usage of the library the Committee chose the academic year 2019-20 (since the library usage was less during the previous academic years due to COVID-19 pandemic).

5 random days were chosen from the academic year 2019-20 and the number of students who accessed the library during those days was taken from the library log book. The average of these 5 numbers was calculated and was considered the average number of students using the library per day.

Five random days and no: of footfalls -

02/08/2019 - 227

23/09/2019 - 224

01/10/2019 - 227

26/11/2019 - 248

22/01/2020 - 230

Average number of students using the library per day (physically) = 231

Along with this the total number of page hits during the academic year 2019-21 was calculated to be 7315 from the NLIST usage report. This was divided by the total number of working days (194) to obtain the average number of students using the library per day via e-access.

Average number of students using the library per day (e-access) = 38

Average number of students using the library per day = 269

As per the Library Policy of the institution, all the teachers have to mark a mandatory 1 hour library usage every day. Hence the average number of teachers using the library per day can thus be considered as the total number of teachers in the institution during 2019-20.

Average number of teachers using the library per day = 150

Average number of teachers and students using the library per day = 419

Then the "percentage per day usage of library by teachers and students" is calculated using the formula given.
