






#### **ONAM CELEBRATIONS**


#### INTERNATIONAL OZONE DAY CELEBRATIONS


#### **CHRISTMAS DAY CELEBRATIONS**








#### **ALBERTIAN MINI MARATHON RUN**


















#### **ANNUAL SPORTS MEET**





### **POSTER MAKING COMPETITION**






## PALM PRINT

### THALIR – CULTURAL EVENT








#### LOGO CONTEST

The campus is situ the heart of the Kochi city, the business capital of Kerala. The College is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University and is functioning under the management of the Archdiocese of Verapoly. When it was started in 1946, the college was affiliated to the University of Madrae. In 1958, when the Kerala University Act came into force, the affiliation was shifted to Kerala University and subsequently, in 1983 when the Mahatma Gandhi University was established, the College came under The established, the College came under Mahatma Gandhi University. The College comes under Section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act. In 2009, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) awarded A Accreatization Council (NAAC) awarded A grade to the College, in the re-accreditation process. The Peer Team has observed, 'obtaining autonomy' as one of the Institutional Opportunities. The college received ISO 9001: 2008 certifications in 2010 after the audit conducted by TÜV Rheinland and surveillance are conducted every year. The College has been selected for the award of Star College Status' by the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India in 2013. The College is a backward minority educational institution covered under article 30 of the constitution of India. Co.

St Albert's College (Autonomous) in association with Cochin Arts Communication (CAC) organised a Ecumenical Carol Singing Competition on 6th January 2019




#### **CHAKRAVYUHA- QUIZ COMPETITION**


#### THE APPRENTICE- THE SCHOOL QUIZ


#### SAMANVAYA – FUSION DANCE COMPETITION




## **ALBERTINE 2020**
