## ENCON CULTURAL PROGRAMME

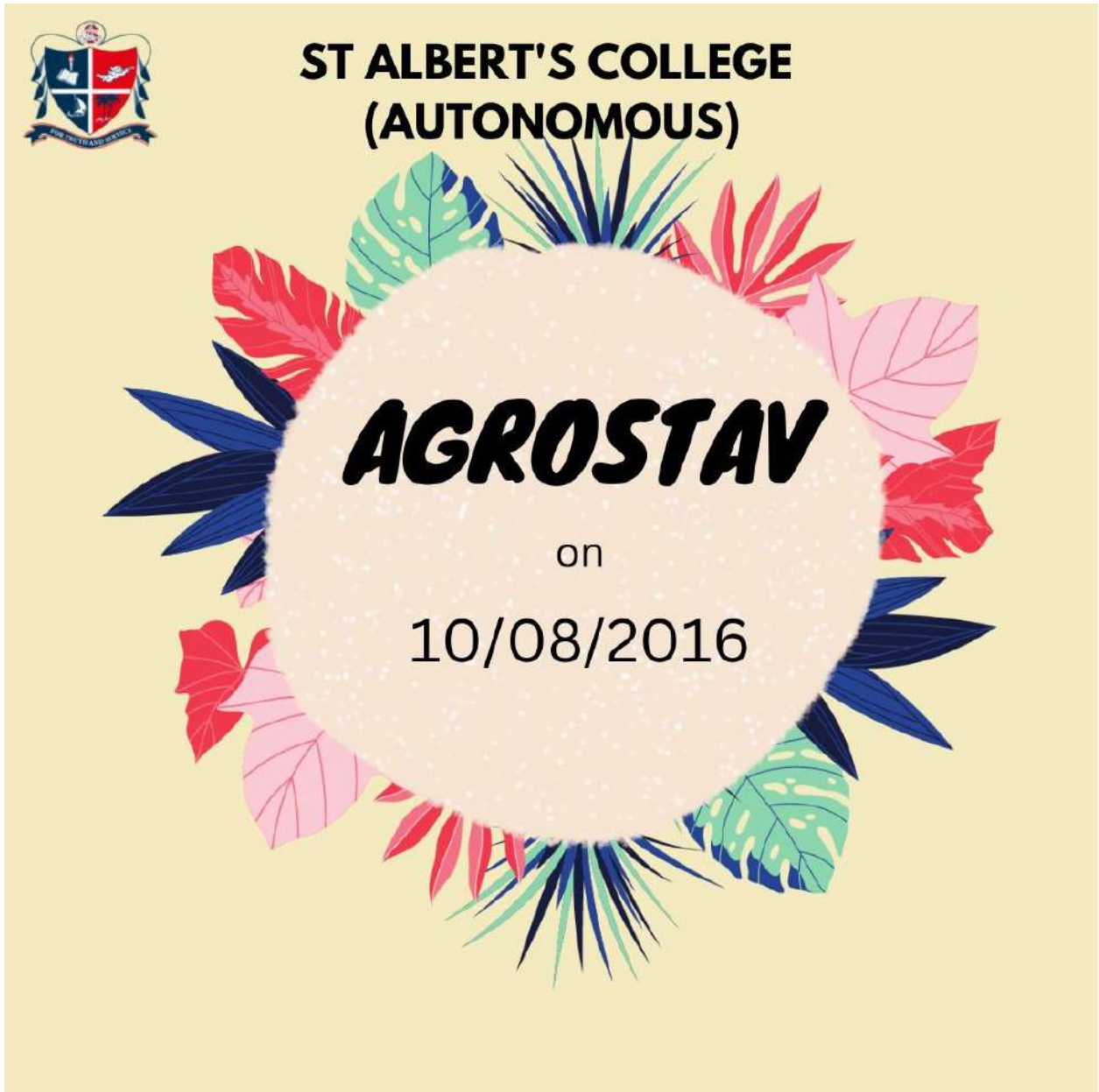

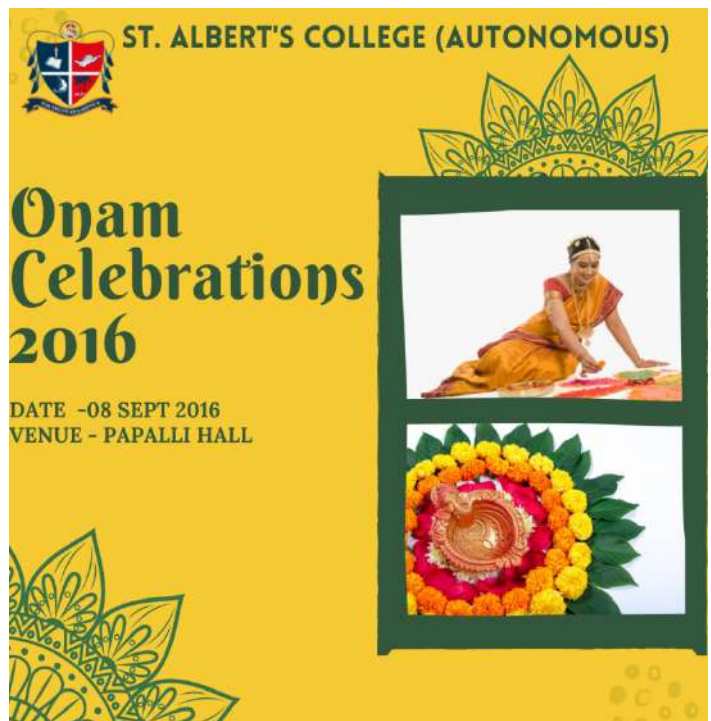






## ONAM CELEBRATIONS

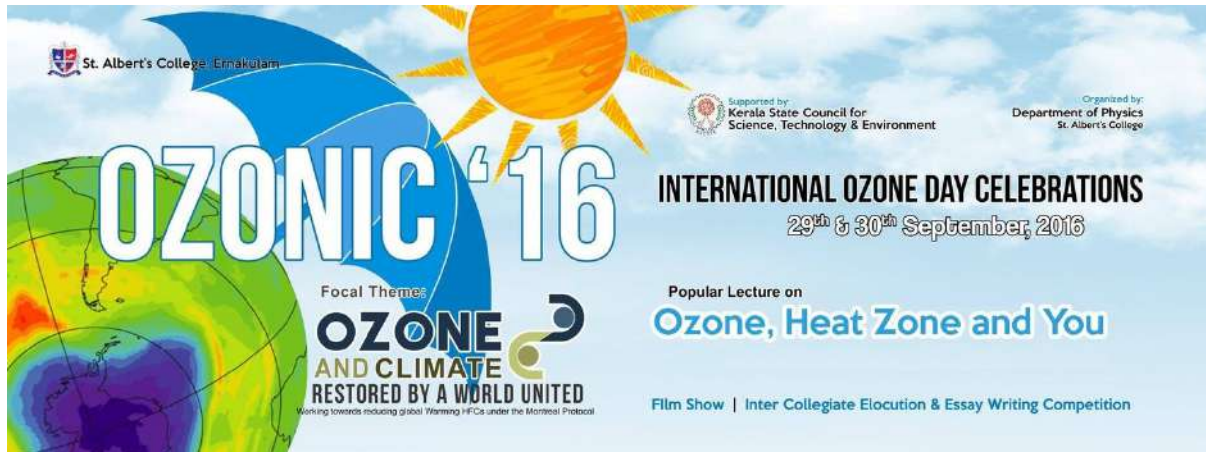

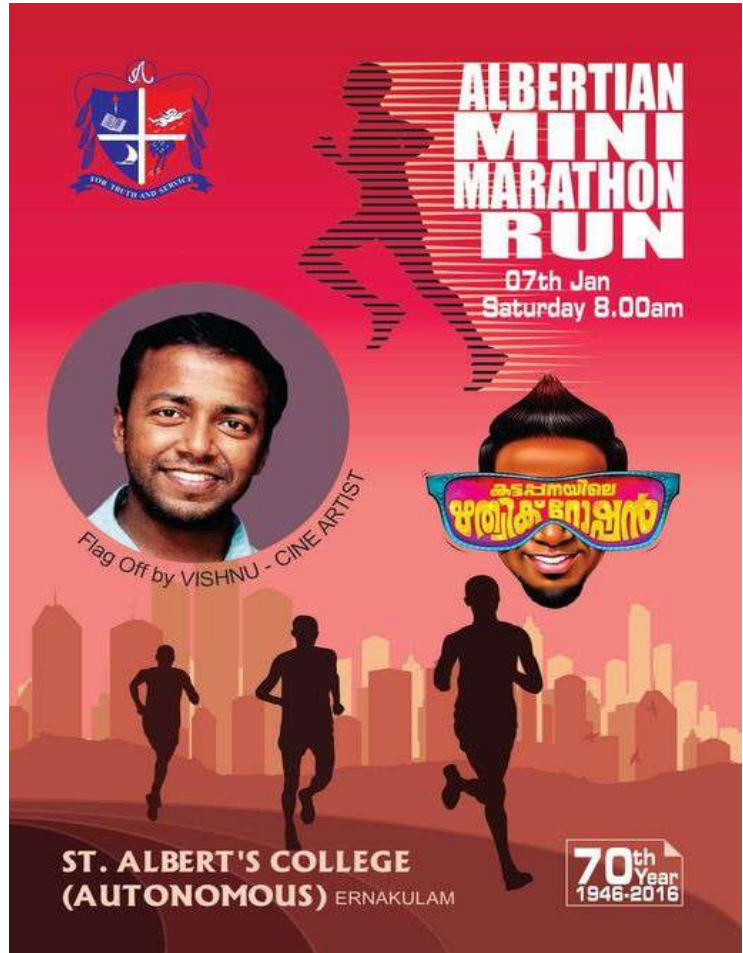

## ANNUAL SPORTS MEET





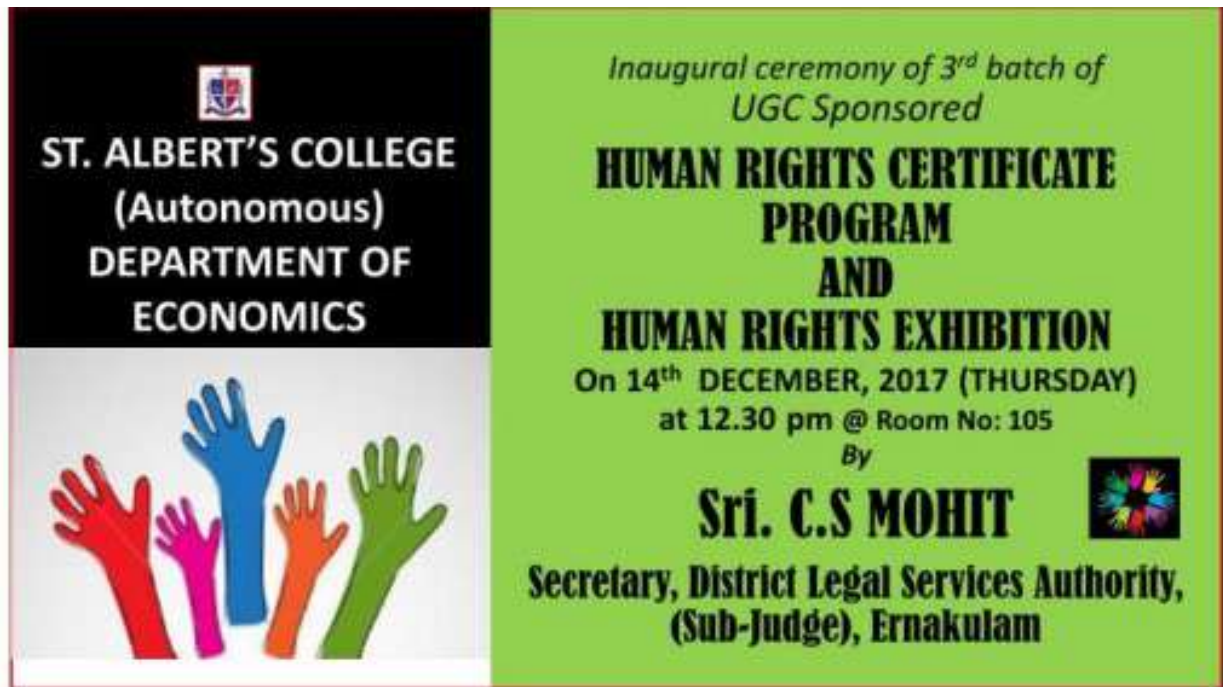








## HUMAN RIGHTS EXHIBITION

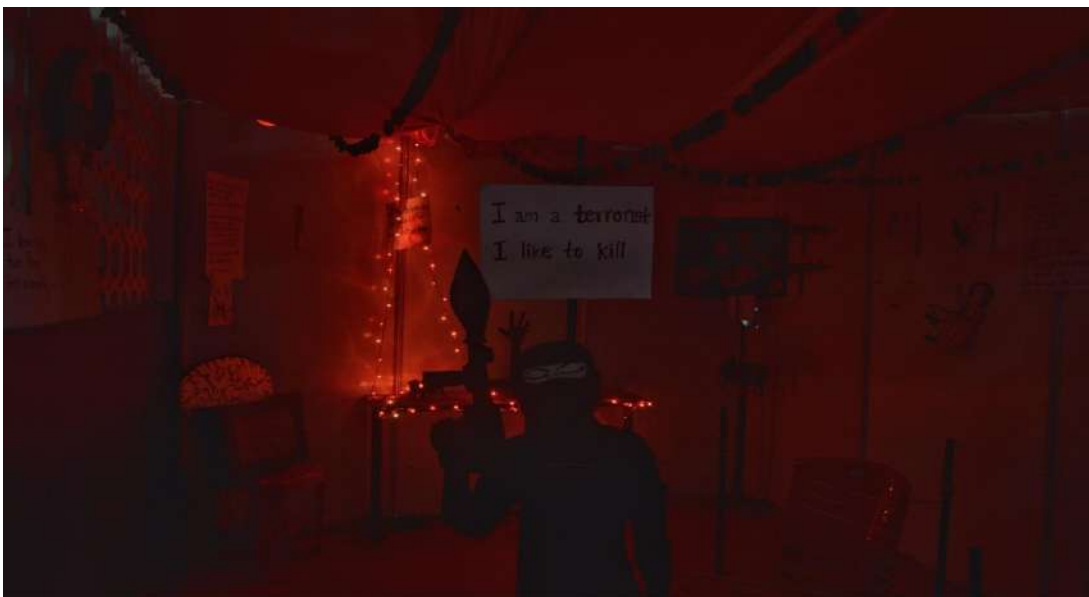
## ALBERTIAN INTERNATIONAL EDUCATIONAL EXPO
