

The College has consistently worked in the areas of environment and sustainability, education, medical assistance, disaster management, nation building etc. Different Social Outreach activities are organized by the college to create awareness in the students about societal needs. These activities also play a major role in building institute-community engagement, enabling the students to experience life at the grass root level. All the departments are actively engaged in organizing a wide variety of outreach initiatives, thus giving the Albertian family an opportunity to work closely to fulfil not only the needs of the society but also to inculcate the values of “Truth & Service” in the students.

Express Features

The first-year degree students of St Albert's College, Ernakulam visited the House of Providence, an Old Age Home, as part of a social outreach programme. They interacted with inmates, bathed them, cleaned the surroundings, fed them, made beds, cut their nails and did many such activities which brought a smile on the faces of the inmates.

And it had a positive impact on the students. Says Anusree Venu, a first-year BA student, "The feeling that we got while interacting with the inmates cannot be expressed by words. The most important thing I found was that they did not complain about their children who dumped them there. They are a group of loving mothers, with plenty of knowledge and good thoughts especially Violet Amma." For another student, Raison John, it was a new experience. "We learned how to behave with our elders," he says. "Now we understood how much pain these people have when their children leave them alone. We have realised how much a single smile can bring happiness to a person. Providing love and receiving their blessings brought us the greatest joy."

Francis Christo Kuballo, a student of the Mathematics Department, says, "Each and every life is precious. Respecting elder people is divine. One day we will also reach this age. We can never take for granted that this will happen to only a few. This is the law of nature. So we should aspire to be kind to others." This social outreach programme is one among the many that has been earmarked for the students as part of SAVE - St. Albert's Voluntary Executive. The rationale behind SAVE is that man is a social animal. "However, due to technological advancement, nuclear families, urbanisation and a fast-life, social interactions are being limited to communication via social media and telephone," says Dr M C Sabu, coordinator, Master of Social Work (MSW). "The majority of the people, especially in a city, do not know their neighbors. This social isolation is the root cause of most of the modern-day problems."

This growing predicament led the visionaries of St. Albert's College to come up with the idea to sensitise the youth about the different strata of the society and to familiarise them with their problems so that, the youth may become capable of addressing it.

"Students of the SAVE programme have to do at least one day of Social Service in a Non-Governmental Organization which focuses on thrust areas like old age, women and children in need of care and protection, hospitalised patients and the differently-abled," says MSW Faculty Subhadra Menon.

The programme mainly focuses on the first-year students. They go for SAVE programmes only on Saturdays and take part in the activities of the agency as per the guidance given by the agency supervisor.

Collector reviews geobag filling work at Chellanam

Kochi: District collector S Suhas on Sunday visited Chellanam to view the progress of work to secure the coastal stretch from frequent sea erosion and put a stop to frequent flooding of homes.

Suhas visited the region to take stock of the progress of filling of geotextile bags ahead of the official review. The irrigation department, which is in charge of the project, said out of 4,450 geobags they had purchased as part of the project, 3,675 bags had been distributed. Rest of the bags numbering 775 have been kept at taluk office at Fort Kochi to meet emergency needs, they said. Suhas informed the coastal residents that the district administration would take all the necessary steps to expedite the work using geotextile tubes.

Suhas who visited Velankanny church in the locality also had lunch from the house of Martin Kuttappassery. The collector also lauded the students of St Albert's and St Teresa's College, who volunteered to fill geobags at Chellanam.

Bulk of the bags are being put up along the coast at areas like Companypady, Bazaar and Velankanni North at Chellanam panchayat, which had been experiencing severe sea erosion ever since the start of the monsoon. District collector was accompanied by Kochi tahsildar K V Ambros, irrigation department assistant engineer Santosh and members of panchayat.

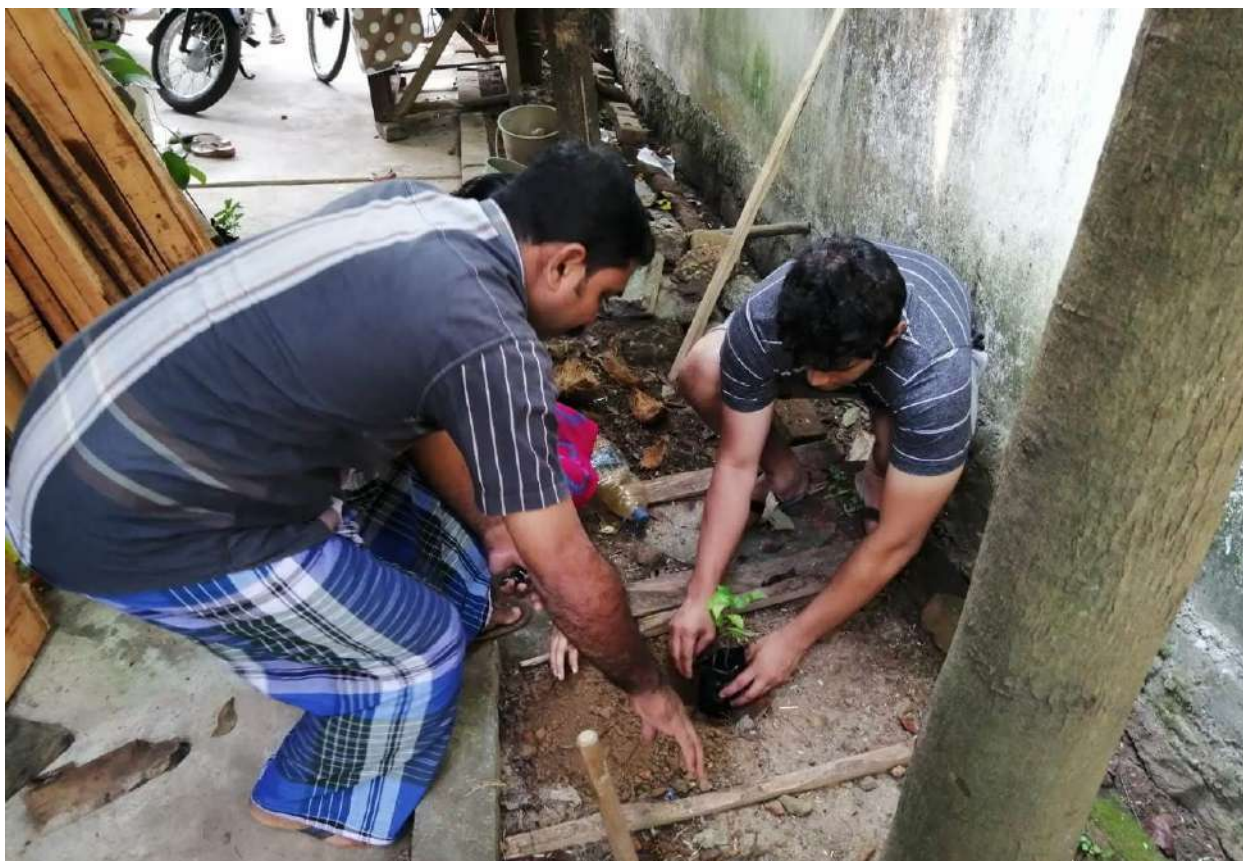

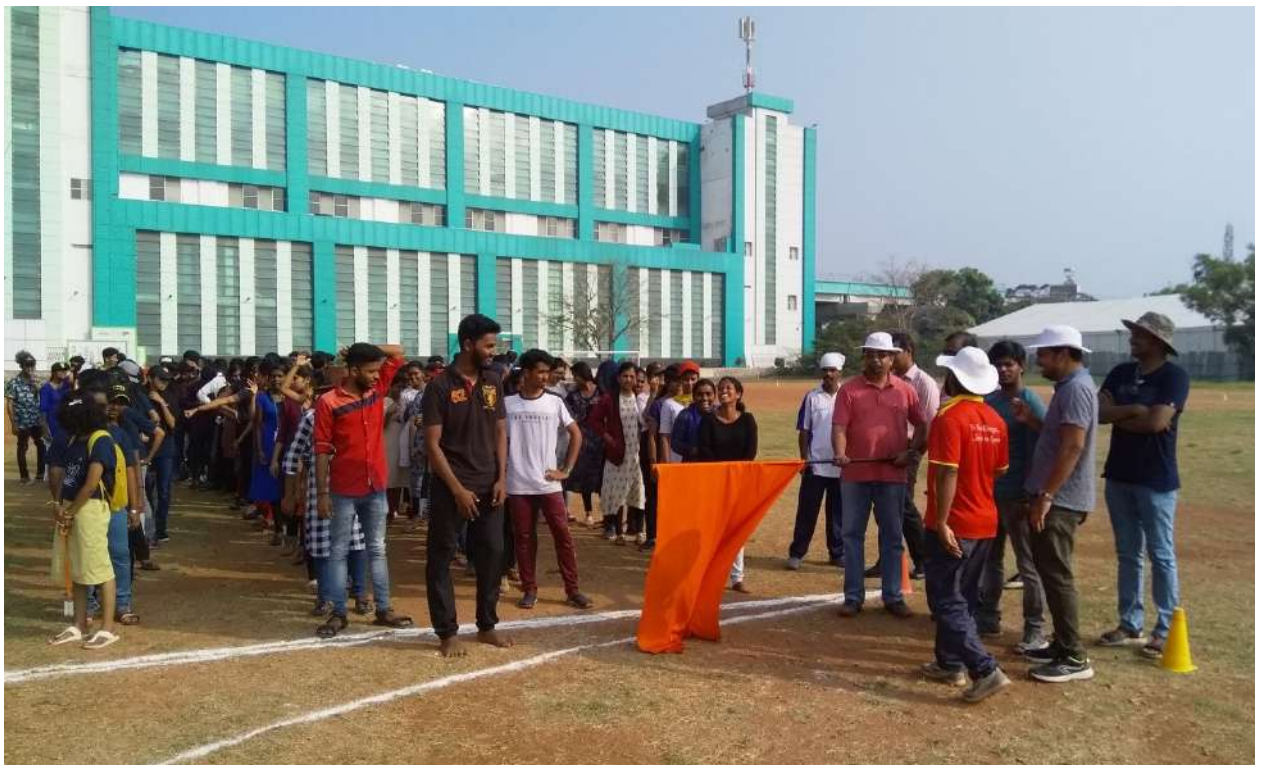
SPORTS AND ARTS

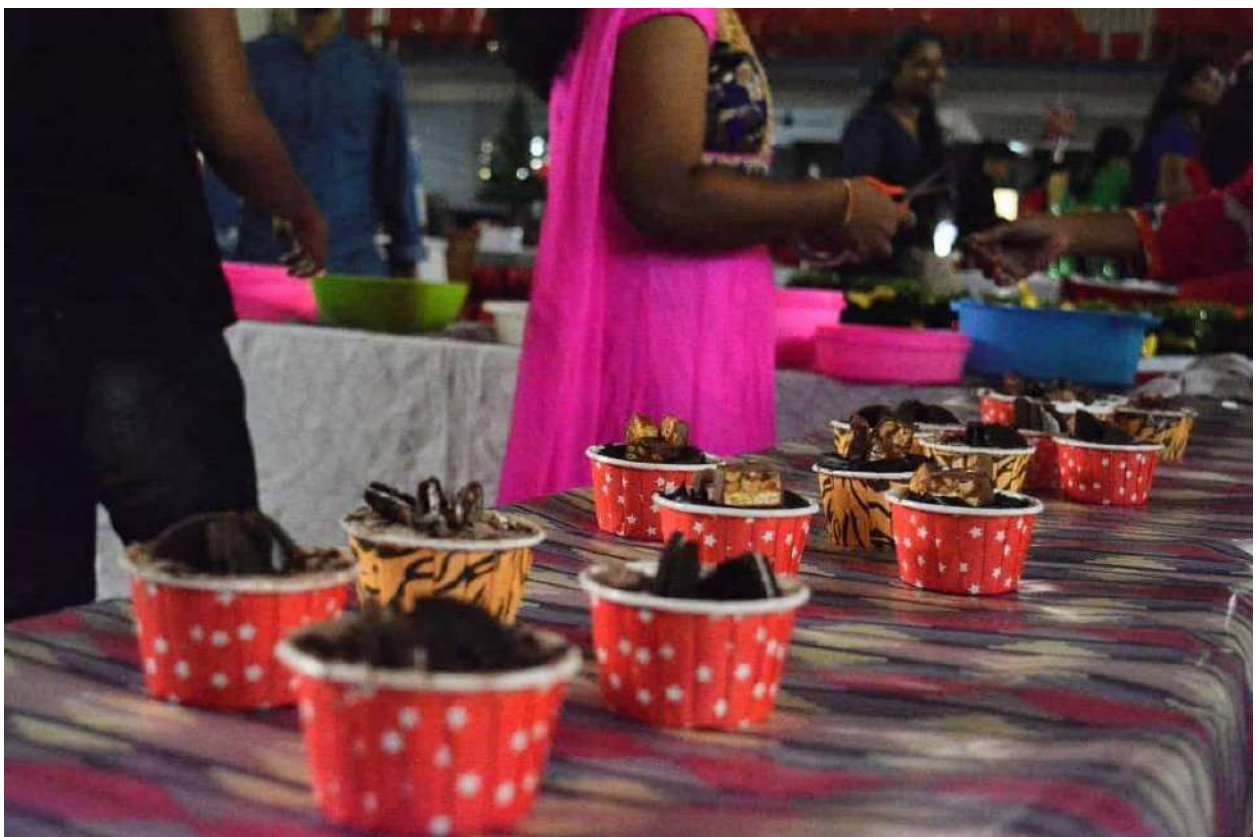



















SEMINARS & CONFERENCES
