### On the Path of Excellence



#### Aquafarm at Kadamakkudy

St. Albert's College (Autonomous) Aqua-farm at Cheriya Kadamakkudy village, Pizhala, Ernakulam was established in the year 1998 under the Department of Aquaculture. The aqua-farm has an area of 2.5 acres complemented by the availability of nearly one-meter tidal amplitude from the Cochin backwaters which ensures sufficient oxygenation through water exchange and waste exclusion for the aquatic produce. Preliminary observation revealed the presence of finfishes like Mullet, Milkfish, Pearl spot, Orange chromide, and shellfishes like White shrimp, Tiger prawn, Flower prawn, and Mud crab.

The "Harvest Festival" conducted during the years 2007 and 2010 for the first time in Kerala was a remarkable highlight of the facility. Participants from the College and also from neighbouring institutions took part in the "Cooking Competition" as well as various cultural activities at the farm site. At present, the aqua-farm is highly useful to the students in conducting project works in the areas of water and soil quality analysis, fish and plankton studies, and in aquaculture engineering aspects. Every year the students are exposed to seeding activities, feeding experiments, and harvesting operations in the farm. At present, the farm is utilized for culturing tiger prawn *Penaeus monodon* which is a high-value species and has a good export market as well.



## Lecture Series on Tax – III Input Tax Credit and Registration Process



## The Department of Computer Science


### Albertian Swatchatha Classroom

As part of Albertian Swatchatha classroom, the students of the Department of Computer Science cleaned their own homes on 3 October, 2021







## NBHM Entrance Coaching Sessions




### Expert Talk on Media Ethics


