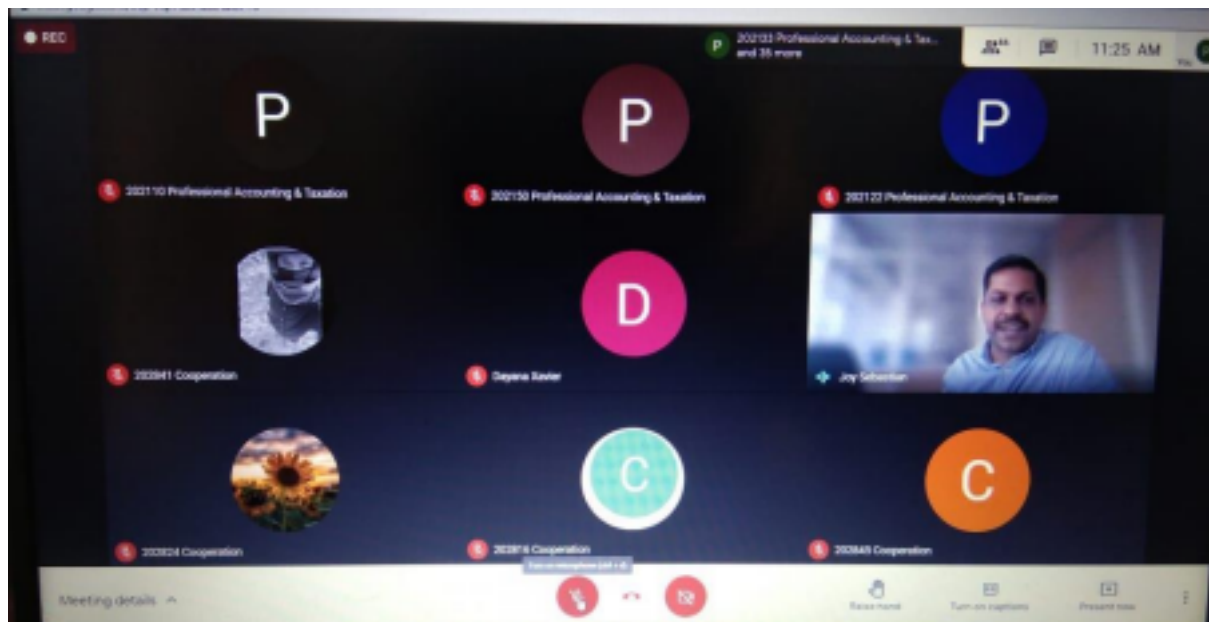
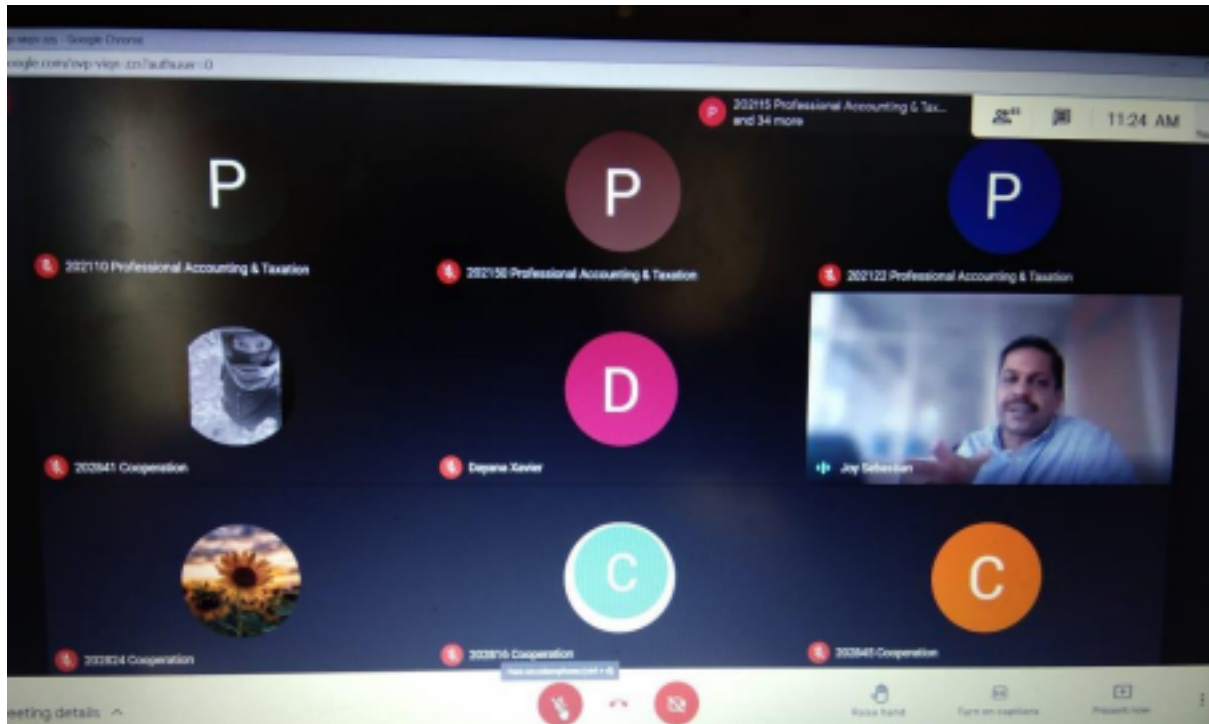
REPORT

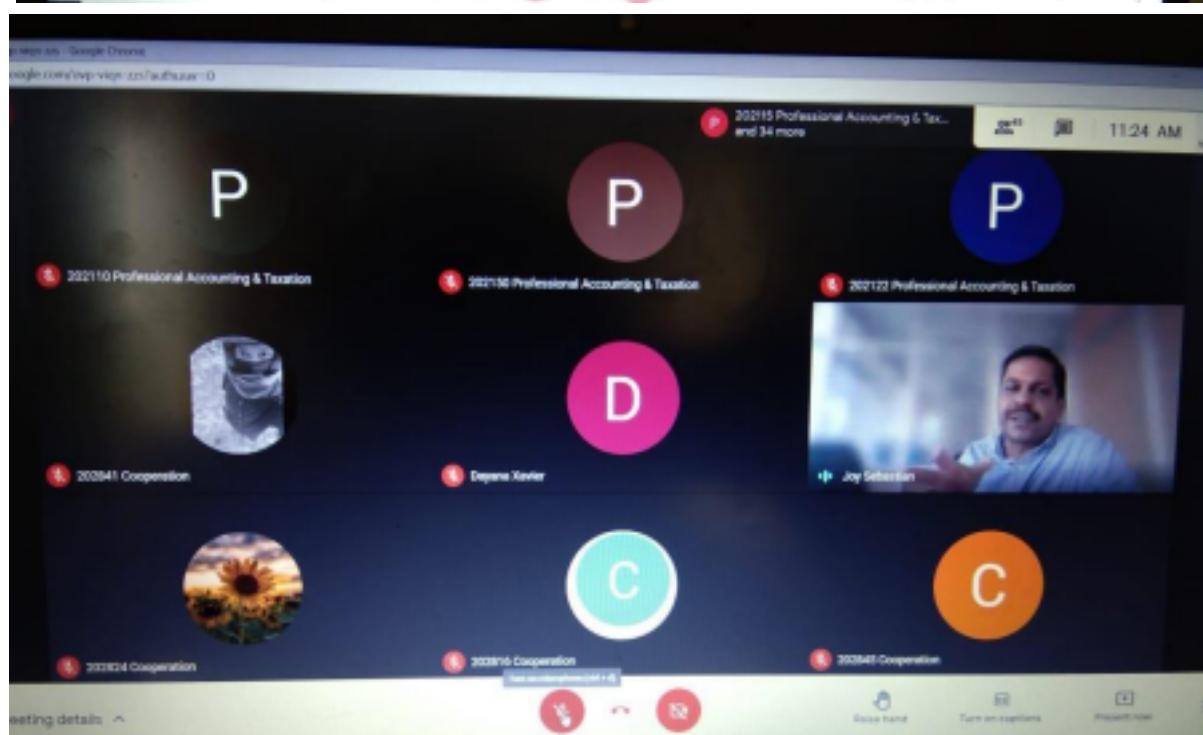
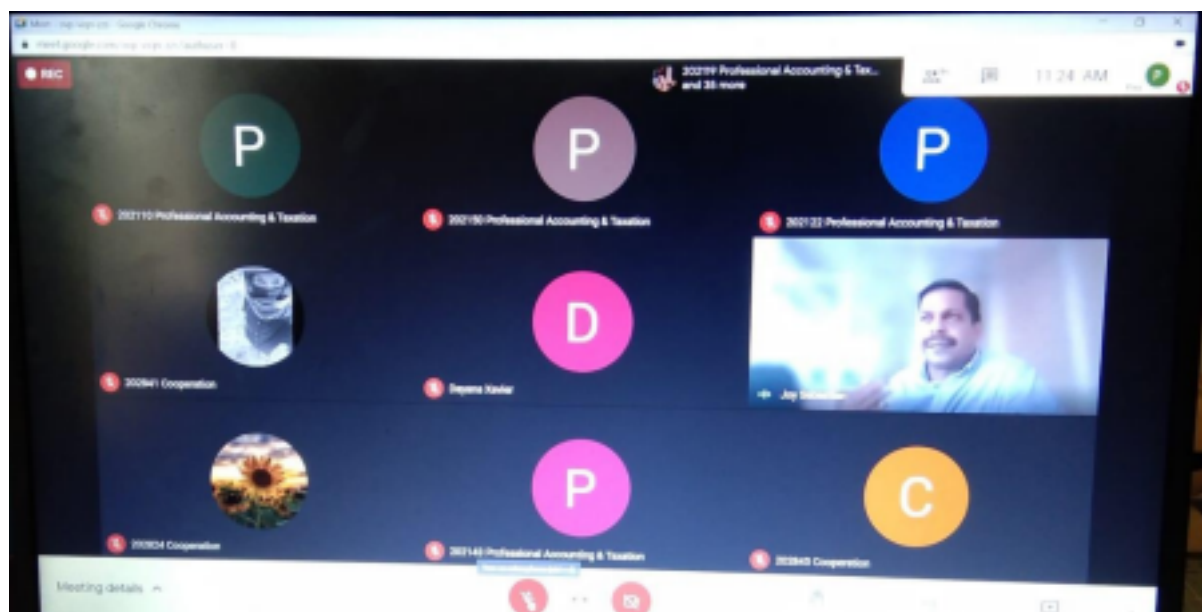
