As an initiative to provide expert lectures to the students, the department of Commerce (SF) of St. Albert's College (Autonomous)Ernakulam, conducted a webinar on the topic - 'Winding up of the Companies On 26th May 2021. The webinar was conducted for the students of B.com Taxation (SF) and B.com Computer Applications.

CS Nikhil George Pinto was both the chief guest and the resource person of the webinar. The webinar was compatible with our studies and gave deep insights into the topic. Chaitra Vijayachandran of B.com Taxation (SF) was the host of the session. The welcome speech and vote of thanks were delivered by Levin Jose of B.com Taxation (SF) and Shone Hendrixon of B.com Computer Applications respectively.

CS Nikhil George Pinto started the session with a power point presentation. Before moving into further concepts, he gave a brief description on the difference between the terms 'Winding up' and 'Dissolution' with respect to a company. He pointed out that the current syllabus provided in the textbook are not updated about the yearly changes that occur in the Companies Act 2013 and hence requires updation on the same. He further added that certain provisions which were formerly a part of the Companies Act 2013 is now removed with the introduction of IBC 2016. He mentioned and pointed out such changes in his lecture.

Later he discussed the modes of winding up and talked in detail about the process of winding up, the dissolution of a company and what are its legal formalities. The entire concept was thoroughly covered in 1- 1half hours. The webinar gave the students a clear cut image of how the winding up of the company would be and how the whole provision is bound by laws specified in the Companies Act 2013. The most important part of the session was the separate Q&A, where the students were given the opportunity

to clear their doubts. He also shared his contact information with the students for further queries if any.
