## Whereas

3. BLUEANCHOR is a leading logistics company offering a range of logistics services, including trucking, air freight, ocean freight, and warehousing.
4. BLUEANCHOR is desirous to associate with ALBERTS, on various areas as discussed in the purview of this MoU, which will be mutually beneficial to both organizations.

That, relying on the principle of good faith, by virtue of which they will carry out all the possible actions for their due fulfillment, And relying also on their common bonds and concerns, they state their interest in strengthening their relationships through academic cooperation, and for this end they are of one accord in entering this MoU.

## NOW THEREFORE THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS

5. ALBERTS and BLUEANCHOR recognize that this collaboration would be of mutual benefit and would provide strengths in research and education and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic and cultural cooperation. As per the purpose of the said agreement, all the parties shall undertake the following activities with the approval of the authorized signatory authorities.
  - a) ALBERTS and BLUEANCHOR can collaborate in future to conduct lectures, workshops, seminars, research conferences and similar events in areas of mutual interest for the benefit of students, Institutes, Corporate sectors and society at large.
  - b) Internship / On the Job Training: the BLUEANCHOR shall provide Internship / On the Job Training to students of ALBERTS that shall cover such periods of time as may from time to time be mutually agreed upon by the parties. The starting and ending date for Internship shall be agreed upon at least one month before the placement commences (There shall be no discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, creed, sex, age, disability, in either the selection of students for participation in the program, or as to any aspect of Internship / On the Job Training).

- c) BLUEANCHOR shall deliver live cases/problems faced in the industry where the students of the other party can have access for class-room discussion. The outcome of such discussions may be shared with BLUEANCHOR for evaluation/assess the practicality of the solution to the existing problem.
- d) BLUEANCHOR shall deliver industry lectures at ALBERTS for the development of students with no monetary obligation on either party.
- e) BLUEANCHOR shall consider recruiting students from ALBERTS through a diligent recruitment process.

**No Employment Relationship:**

- 6. The parties agree that this Agreement shall not be construed in any manner as establishing any kind of partnership or bond of a labor nature between them. Thus, in all activities stemming from the present MoU and from subsequent specific action plans, the parties are in the understanding that, in all cases, employment relationships shall remain in force between the employing institution and its respective personnel.

**Autonomy:**


- 7. This agreement is a statement of intentions and does not involve, in any instance whatsoever, any financial obligations between the subscribing institutions.

**Conflict Resolution:**

- 8. Any dispute resulting from the interpretation or application of this Agreement shall be settled through direct negotiation and common agreement by the persons delegated to such end by each party. Either party may propose to the other a modification of the Agreement at any time in writing.

**Amendments:**

- 9. The parties may amend or amplify this Agreement through agreements in writing to that effect. Said amendments or additions will be binding on the signatories as of the date of their signature. The parties may not assign, in whole or in part, the performance of the present MoU to any third party, except through prior and express authorization in writing

by both of them. And since both parties are in agreement regarding the content of the present document, and as a token of conformity, we sign it in two counterparts, both of which will be considered originals.

**Costs:**

10. Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this MoU. Where possible and appropriate, the Parties may also seek funding for collaborations from any research organization funding. Where applicable, the fee for services from BLUEANCHOR to ALBERTS and vice-versa will be as agreed with the approvals of the signatory authorities.

**Applicable Law and Jurisdiction:**

11. Any disputes or issues of interpretation with regard to this MoU shall be resolved amicably between the Parties. In case no amicable solution is found such disputes or issues shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of three (3) arbitrators mutually agreed by the parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English. The seat of the arbitration shall be in a mutually agreed location. This MoU shall be governed by and construed under the laws of India and would be tried in the jurisdiction of courts in Ernakulam district.

**Indemnity:**

12. Each Party agrees to protect, defend, indemnify and hold harmless the other Party and their related parties from and against all liability, claims, loss, damage, and costs (including legal costs and expenses) due to its failure to perform as agreed in the MoU.

**Assignment:**

13. Neither party will assign its rights or obligations under this MoU without the prior written consent of the other party, however such requests shall not be withheld unreasonably. This MoU will be binding upon the parties and their respective legal successors and permitted assigns.

**Confidentiality:**

15. Students might be working on confidential projects and should not be disclosing any confidential information. Students cannot share data collected during the study in any of their assignments, however are free to share their learnings without impacting confidentiality agreements with clients.

**Term:**

16. This MOU shall be effective for a period of one (1) year from the date of execution of this agreement, and shall be automatically renewed thereafter for another one (1) year unless a written notice to terminate or amend this agreement is given to the other party One (1) month in advance.
